





MEMORANDOM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

RAJSHREE INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT & TECHNOLOGY (BAREILLY, UTTAR PRADESH, INDIA)

AND

OSH TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY NAMED AFTER M.M. ADYSHEVA (KYRGYZSTAN, OSH, ST. ISANOVA, 81)

CONTRACT

On cooperation between Osh Technological University named after M.M. Adysheva (Kyrgyzstan, Osh, st. Isanova, 81) and Rajshree Institute of Management & Technology (Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh, India).

Osh Technological University named after. M.M. Adysheva (Kyrgyzstan, Osh, st. Isanova, 81) and Rajshree Institute of Management & Technology (Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh, India), hereinafter referred to as the "Parties", have entered into this agreement as follows:

1. THE SUBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

In order to cooperate in the educational, scientific, technical and innovative field of activities, to ensure the development of a system of partnerships between the Educational Institutions, the Parties agreed to work in the following areas:

- 1.1. Conducting fundamental and applied research work, within the framework of joint projects based on scientific centers and laboratories.
- 1.2. Training of students, Bachelors, masters & PhD students within the framework of integration education, science & production in the areas of training of the Parties.
- 1.3. Implementation of joint/dual-degree educational programs, professional education, training of highly qualified personnel, as well as training, retraining and (or) advanced training of scientific and scientific-pedagogical workers.
- 1.4. Carrying out applied, search, scientific research and development in the field of exact, natural, technical, social and human sciences, as well as interdisciplinary research and development.
- 1.5. Creating conditions for the exchange of ideas, information and technologies, as well as organizing joint research and development within agreed priority areas.
- Organization of joint academic & scientific activities, such as Lectures, conferences, seminars, webinars, symposiums and Exhibitions.
- 1.7. Exchange of publications and other informational materials of mutual interest.
- 1.8. Any other collaborative efforts the parties consider being appropriate from time to time.

2. FORMS OF INTERACTION

in the process of implementing cooperation under this Agreement, the parties may organize the following forms of interaction:

- 2.1. Joint meetings and discussions on the subject of the Agreement.
- 2.2. Exchange of information (through the Parties sending each other messages, calls, letters, etc.) related to the area of cooperation, including information about the needs for the results of the

Parties' activities and opportunities to meet these needs.

- 2.3. Consultations on issues related to the activities of the Parties and of mutual interest.
- 2.4 Planning of joint activities (development of programs) aimed at achieving the goals of this Agreement.
- 2.5. Preparation and implementation of joint research programs, research work in certain scientific areas, including programs and projects with international participation.
- 2.6. Organization of scientific and technical expertise of projects and programs and other types of expertise with the participation of employees of the Parties.
- 2.7. Academic exchange of specialists within the framework of educational and scientific programs for the purpose of teaching and lecturing.
- 2.8. Mutual exchange of students, undergraduates and doctoral students, creation of the necessary conditions for deepening theoretical and practical knowledge, for practical training.
- 2.9. Organization of joint conferences, seminars, symposiums, exhibitions and other forms of presentation of research results.

In cases where a relationship arises where one or the other Party entrusts the other Party with performing specific work stipulated by this Agreement, which involves remuneration for the performance of work, such relationships are formalized in separate contracts (agreements) for the provision of services and performance of work with reference to this Agreement.

3. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

- 3.1. The parties, based on their professional competence, skills, availability of material and financial resources, have the right:
- 3.1.1. Exchange information on promising scientific and innovative projects and educational programs within the framework of the current legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic and India. Request the necessary information on issues that are the subject of cooperation under this Agreement.
 - 3.1.2. Exchange experience on issues that are the subject of cooperation under this Agreement.
- 3.1.3. Organize consultations, lectures, retraining courses and other forms of advanced training for the Parties, invite them in joint meetings, seminars, and webinars.
- 3.1.4. Involve employees, teachers, specialists, and expert, consultants of the other Party to work and participate in joint projects organized for the purpose of implementing this Agreement.
- 3.1.5. Involve the other Party in organizing and conducting joint events for expert assessment of scientific and technical developments.
- 3.1.6. Draw up and conclude contracts, other contracts and agreements for the performance of research and applied work.
 - 3.1.7. Perform other work and interactions within the scope of the Agreement.
- 3.2. The parties, based on their professional and production competence, skills, and availability of material and financial resources, undertake to:
 - 3.2.1. Systematically discuss issues related to the implementation of the areas of cooperation.
- 3.2.2. Consider problems that arise in the process of implementing this Agreement and make agreed decisions on them.
 - 3.2.3. Comply with ethical standards, rules of conduct and daily routine of the Parties.
 - 3.2.4. Comply with official, commercial & other protected laws of the Kyrgyz Republic and India.
- 3.2.5. Ensure security, level of access rights and access control to information and documentation received from the other Party.
- 3.2.6. Do not use intellectual property, patents, know-how for commercial purposes without the agreement of the other Party.
 - 3.2.7. Do not disclose the results of joint activities without the consent of both Parties.
- 4.1 Specific forms of cooperation between the Parties are stipulated in separate contracts or agreements, taking into account the wishes of the Parties on all aspects of activity.
- 4.2 This Agreement was concluded without mutual financial conditions of the Parties. Financial

conditions are specified in agreements that are additionally concluded between the Parties.

4.3 As part of the implementation of this Agreement, the Parties provide protection rights to the results of intellectual activity.

4.4 Any changes and additions to the terms of this Agreement are formalized by additional agreements and come into force from the moment they are signed by both Parties.

- 4.5 This Agreement is concluded for a period of five years and is automatically extended for each subsequent year, unless either Party notifies the other Party in writing of its intention to terminate it no later than three months before the expiration of its next term. Termination of this Agreement does not affect the fulfillment of obligations under contracts concluded on its basis.
- 4.6 This Agreement is drawn up in two copies of the same legal force and one copy is kept by each of the Parties.
