3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by TR ANTALYA 05 no later than the end of March for the 1st semester students, and no later than the end of September for the 2nd semester and full year students, after the assessment period has finished.

4. Termination of the agreement

The partner institutions will agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the *international agreement*. However, in the event of *unilateral termination*, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."


