**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU")
BETWEEN
Giresun University, Türkiye**

**and
OSH TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY NAMED AFTER M.M. ADYSHEV (hereinafter
referred to as "OshTU"), KYRGYZSTAN**

PURPOSE

Article 1.

This MoU shall come into effect upon its signature by Prof. Dr. Yılmaz CAN, representing the Giresun University and by **Tursunbayev Zhanbolot ZHANYSHOVICH**, representing **OSH TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY NAMED AFTER M.M. ADYSHEV**. The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for academic, administrative, and training collaboration between the Parties, aiming to strengthen undergraduate and graduate programs through mutual cooperation.

SCOPE

Article 2.

The Parties agree to engage in academic and scientific collaboration in mutually agreed-upon fields. This cooperation shall include joint initiatives in undergraduate and graduate education and training; exchange of academic literature and research materials; organization of joint academic events such as conferences, seminars, and symposia; and professional development programs for academic and administrative staff. Specific areas of cooperation are further detailed in Article 3.

AREAS OF COOPERATION AND SOLIDARITY

Article 3.

The Parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:

- a. Student and staff mobility with provisions for the mutual recognition of academic credits earned abroad.
- b. Exchange of academic and scientific information, including publications, research materials, and other educational resources.
- c. Joint organization of scientific events, such as conferences, panels, seminars, symposia, and workshops.
- d. Collaboration on research projects, including proposals, joint applications, and pilot initiatives.
- e. Additional areas of cooperation may be proposed and implemented upon mutual agreement, in accordance with Article 8.



PRINCIPLES OF COOPERATION AND SOLIDARITY

Article 4.

The Parties shall conduct their collaboration according to the following principles:

- a. Organize short- and long-term visits for academic and administrative staff for conferences, training, project collaboration, and consultation.
- b. Facilitate short- and long-term teaching assignments for academic staff, including seminars and academic consultations.
- c. Support the invitation of researchers, scholars, and artists to participate in academic activities such as lectures, conferences, and panels.
- d. Strengthen ties with international scholars and institutions to expand collaborative international projects and provide internships for students.
- e. Assist in the planning and implementation of institutional visits.
- f. Additional principles or methods may be introduced upon mutual agreement, in accordance with Article 8.

FINANCIAL AFFAIRS

Article 5.

Each Party shall bear its own costs for cooperative activities under this MoU, subject to its available budgetary resources. In cases where additional funding is required, both Parties shall seek potential funding opportunities from national and international sources to support joint initiatives. Specific financial arrangements for individual activities shall be outlined in separate implementing agreements, as necessary.

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

Article 6.

The Parties shall develop detailed implementation plans through formal subsidiary agreements between relevant units of each university. These work plans shall be structured in alignment with academic calendars or annual cycles and annexed to this MoU. Representatives designated by both Parties shall jointly evaluate the outcomes upon the conclusion of each implementation period.

EXECUTION

Article 7.

The provisions of this MoU shall be executed by the Legal Representatives of the respective universities. Authorized individuals may be appointed to manage the execution of specific projects and implementation plans under the authority of the Legal Representatives.

UNSPECIFIED MATTERS

Article 8.

Proposals to amend this MoU may be submitted by either Party at any time, which shall only take effect upon written approval by the Legal Representatives and the Senate of both universities. Disputes arising from the interpretation or implementation of this MoU shall be resolved through mutual

consultation and in accordance with applicable laws. Both Parties shall comply with the academic and administrative regulations at their universities, and may amend this MoU or relevant internal regulations as needed, provided such amendments adhere to this Article.

VALIDITY AND TERMINATION

Article 9.

This MoU shall be signed by the Legal Representatives of both Parties and shall remain in effect for an initial period of five (5) years. Annual review meetings may be held to address operational matters. Unless either Party provides written notice of termination at least six (6) months prior to the expiration date, this MoU shall automatically renew for an additional five (5) years. Either Party may terminate this MoU with six (6) months' prior written notice, provided that ongoing activities under the current work plan are not disrupted.

LANGUAGE AND COPIES

Article 10.

This MoU, consisting of ten (10) articles, has been prepared in English in two (2) original copies. Each Party shall retain one signed copy. Both copies shall carry equal legal validity and binding.
